- **Come Lord Jesus:** To Health Care Facilities, Hospitals, Medical Centres, Allied Health Facilities and Pharmacies. (Bring healing, care, understanding, shalom peace, teamwork)
- **Come Lord Jesus:** To our Community Leaders, Council Offices, Parliaments, and Places of Governance (Bring unity, understanding, justice, righteousness, truth, the Common Good, wisdom, humility)
- **Come Lord Jesus:** To the families who live and work in our City, our Friends, our Neighbours, the homeless, the marginalised (Bring justice, love, care, inclusion, sharing, shalom peace)
- **Come Lord Jesus:** To the Media and Arts Precincts (Bring creativity, truth, integrity, harmony, joy)
- **Come Lord Jesus:** to the Commercial and Business Interests, the Shopping Centres and local shops. (bring honesty, fairness, integrity, reliability)
- **Come Lord Jesus:** and may the gift of the water of life bring new life, growth and vitality, refreshment, hope, peace, joy, refreshing and security to the dead places/spaces, to the broken places, to the hopeless and the discouraged, to the one who is thirsty, hungry, lonely.
- **Come Lord Jesus:** to our Churches (local, national and global) - bring unity in diversity, tolerance, love, wisdom, shalom. Bring new encounters with your presence Jesus and fill us afresh, give us supernatural Holy Spirit boldness and revive Your work in Your Bride, the Church locally, nationally and globally.
